1. Class B Liquor License- Anthony Smullen -Smulley's on the Bay- 2060 Sand Bar Way- Previously Geanos- Smullen attended meeting and stated he planned to open middle or end of May as he was still waiting for supplies to be delivered. After deliberations Allen motioned to approve the Class B Liquor License, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.
2. Approval for Municipal Clerks and Treasurers Institute Training at UWGB- Action May Be Taken- Allen motioned to approve the training at UWGB, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.
3. Gayle Lindenberg from REL (Robert E Lee & Associates) discussed STP Applications- Lindenberg discussed the upcoming funding from the State and discussed that East Frontage and West Frontier were the first roads that the Town was applying for through the grant.
4. Dan and Shirley Due- The Dues asked to be placed on the agenda to ask about some things they were having troubles within the Town since they moved in 4 years ago. Speed on South Chase was the first concern they voiced. The second was for barking dogs. Discussion was had for both topics and the Dues thanked the Board.
5. Resolution-R2203 Bridge Aid Petition-Action May Be Taken- Ragen explained the petition for the aid. Allen motioned to approve, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.
6. Little Suamico Fire Department Report-Zuge reported there were 5 calls in March. The concrete was laid for the station approach. Zuge also discussed the options for new Fire trucks, with or without a ladder and pricing. Pribyl suggested getting Bids on the trucks.
7. Community Policing Report- Deputy Baeten went over his monthly report. 125 calls for March with mutiple Meth drug arrests and storage unit break-ins. Deputy Baeten would like to plan a National Night Out at the Park in the future.
8. Road Report- Ragen stated 32 will be closed this summer for bridge repair. Road culvert replacements for Sundew and JoAnna.
9. Planning Commission- Ragen announced the Appointed Planning Commissioners were Elmer Ragen, Ray Polen, and Wesley Kobylarczyk. Alternates being Lisa Glinski, Doug Allen, Al Murphy, and Terry Malcheski.
