2. Owner/Petitioner Big Sky Real Estate, LLP, - Jim Oskey and Glen Calewarts- Request a Plat review of parcel(s) 024293301323 and 024293301532A for Shady Lawn Estates, Second Addition located in the SW/NW ¼ of the NW/SW ¼ of Sec 33, T26N, R20E-Action May be Taken. Glinski read the calls for the month of November. 1 vehicle accident, 1 MABAS with Pensaukee- Structure fire, 1 County Rescue assist, 1 brush fire, 1 CO call- Furnace Issues, 1 fully engulfed garage fire, 1 CO call for vehicle running in the garage. Glinski also reported that the LSFD was given a Thank You card plus multiple gift cards for the garage fire call.
7. Community Policing Report- Officer Baeten attended the meeting and went over the total incident report from November 2021. Baeten asked for more speed limit signs on Cross Road to Sampson. Ragen stated they will put a speed limit sign exactly in between the ones that are up already.
