CALL MEETING TO ORDER-The opening meeting statement was read, and the Town Board of Supervisors monthly meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Chairman Ragen at the Town Hall. The meeting agenda notice was properly posted.

Allen motioned to approve the agenda as printed, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING(S)-Pribyl motioned to approve all three sets of minutes (April 12th Regular meeting, April 15th Special meeting, and April 16th Special meeting), seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

CORRESPONDENCE-Ragen shared the Oconto County Recycling Annual meeting will be held on Thursday, May 13th at 6:00pm.

Business #1: Owner Allan Murphy, Petitioner Bill Kingston-Agent Tim Wirhandwicz-Request a conditional use of parcel 024-18240081221 to add a single-family modular home more than 15 years old located in Sec 24, T26N, R20E-Action May Be Taken-Agent Tim Wirhandwicz of 6210 Duame Road, Lena for petitioner Bill Kingston, presented the CUP request to move the current 1979 modular home located at 1585 Sundew Rd to Lot 21, Shamrock Way to the Town Board. Public comment took place. The following residents had concerns:

1. Mike Trudell-Age of the home and moving it to the new site
2. Frank Nowak-6560 Allen Rd-Inspection to be done prior to moving

Following closed testimony and deliberation, Pribyl motioned to move ahead with no objections to forward the CUP as requested to Oconto County, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #2: OCEDC 2021 Joint Marketing Request-Action May Be Taken-Pribyl motioned to send OCEDC the \$500 Town marketing fee, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #3: Discuss ATC Electric Transmission Line Easement-Action May Be Taken-Action May Be Taken-Allen motioned to accept the ATC proposal to include the herbicidal application and off right of way for a total compensation summary of \$8,850, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #4: Hay Proposals for 16 acres located off Ball Park Rd-Action May Be Taken-No Action Was Taken. Tolzman will send out letters with a deadline of June 1st to the interested parties from the previous year.

Business #5: Proclamation of State of Emergency-Action May Be Taken-Action May Be Taken-Pribyl motioned to extend the current proclamation until September 1, 2021, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #6: Discuss LSF D SCBA's Purchase Request-Action May Be Taken-Zuge submitted an updated Alarm 5SCBA quote. Discussion took place regarding the product warranty, battery life, product care and service and the potential use of ARPA monies. Public comment took place. No action was taken.

Ragen presented on behalf of Archie's Spirits a \$1200 donation to the SmokeEaters Booster Club- President, Bill Schulz.

Business #7: Fire Department Report-Chief Zuge reported 4 calls for the month of April; 2-Hwy 41 car accidents, 1-possible home gas leak and 1-canceled en route Abrams assist. Brown County arson task force is working on suspicious fires in the area.

Business #8: Community Policing Report-Deputy LeBreck reported 145 calls for the month of April. The full report is available on the town website. LeBreck shared highlights regarding the tavern league "drinks to go", the Brown County task force and possible arson fires, increased security monitoring at the local storage units and increased traffic for the summer.

Business #9: Road Report-Ragen shared Oconto County gave quotes to repair Glenview Rd, Sandalwood Rd and Lade Beach Rd for an approximate total cost of \$120,000. Discussion regarding ATV/UTV, E Frontage Rd shouldering and Allen Rd overpass repair also took place.

Business #10: Plan Commission Report-Ragen expressed there may be a business going in on W Frontage Rd and a couple of land division taking place.

Business #11: Set Next Meeting Date-The next meeting date was set for Monday, June 14, 2021.

Business #12: Adjournment- Ragen adjourned the meeting at 7:09pm.
