APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING(S)-Pribyl motioned to approve the minutes of August 9, 2021, Regular meeting, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #1: Owner/Petitioner David & Cynthia Imig-Request a Rezone from Agriculture (Ag) to Rural Residential (RR) for parcel 024-212701114 located in part of the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Sec 27, T26N, R20E-Action May Be Taken-David Imig presented his rezone request. Following Board deliberation, Pribyl made motion to pass this with no objection, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #2: Owner/Petitioner David & Cynthia Imig-Request a Land Division for parcel 024-212701114 located in part of the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Sec 27, T26N, R20E-Action May Be Taken-David Imig presented his land division of 20 acres. Following Board deliberation, Allen made a motion to accept the division with no objection, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #3: Owner/Petitioner Oskey Realty, LLC-Jesse Oskey- Request for Land Division for parcel 024-182400913A located in part of SW ¼ of the NE¼ of Sec 24, T26, R20E-Action May Be Taken- Following Board deliberation and the covenants read, Pribyl motioned to pass this on to Oconto County with no objections, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #4: Training approval- Wisconsin Town's Association Fall Training- \$140.00 for Clerk and Deputy Clerk-Action May Be Taken - Following Board deliberation, Pribyl motioned to pass this with no objections, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #5: Approve Ordinance #02-2021 to Appoint Alternate Members, Glinski and VanDenHeuvel for Board of Review-Action May Be Taken- Following Board deliberation, Pribyl motioned to pass this with no objections, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #6: Discuss snowplowing 2021-2022 proposals-Action May Be Taken- Following Board deliberations, Allen suggested we get proposals for the plowing for the 2021-2022 season. Clerk will put out proposals. Allen made motion to pass with no objections, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.

Business #7: Fire Department Report- Ragen opened with thanking the LSFd for parking the fire trucks roadside front for the Veteran's Parade. Zuge reported there were 8 calls in the month of August which consisted of a grass fire on Allen Rd., 3 County Rescue assists, round hay bale on fire on Bramschreiber Rd, Gas leak on County S, structure fire in Pulaski and a vehicle accident in Abrams. Zuge stated he received 2 bids for the concrete approaches. Air packs are in service. Already were tested and had 2-hour in-service training, with more training at the end of the month. Zuge also put out a reminder out for the food sale on September 18th, 10:00am-2:00pm. Will be serving Burgers, Brats and Boyah.

Business #8: Community Policing Report- Todd Skarban, Andy Vandeberg, Garrot Baeten were all present at the meeting and there was discussion regarding police setting up a sub-station in the LSFd. Officer Vandeberg stated there were 145 calls for the month of August.

Business #9: Road Report-Ragen gave updates on road construction such as, Cross Road project. Ragen stated that the ditches will be getting cut for the last time and blacktopping ends in the middle of October so they're trying to get all that complete.

Business #10: Plan Commission Report- Clerk read a letter of resignation from Brett Jenson effective immediately. Wesley Kobylarczyk will be taking over Jenson's spot immediately.
