Owner/Petitioner Don Wolfgram -Request a Rezone for parcel 024-182402732, would like to change from Agricultural to Residential, located in part of the NW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Sec 24, T26N, R20E-Action May Be Taken- Wolfgram was in attendance and explained the Rezone to the Board. After deliberations Pribyl motioned to approve and send to Oconto County, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.
2. Owner/Petitioner Mathew Christoff- Request a Rezone for parcel 024-31350213402, would like to change from Commercial to Residential, located in the NW ¼ of the NW ¼ of Sec 33, T26N, R20E- Action May Be Taken- Christoff was in attendance and explained the Rezone to the Board. After deliberations Pribyl motioned to send to Oconto County with no objections, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.
3. Owner/Petitioner Jacob Behringer- Request for a Conditional Use for parcel 024-172301422A11, lot 10 in A-B-C-D Estates (Executive Circle), purposed for a headquarters for a fire sprinkler contracting company, located in the NW ¼ of the NW ¼ of Sec 23, T26N, R20E- Action May Be Taken- Andy Otradvec, Contractor, was in attendance and explained the Conditional Use to the Board. Allen motioned to approve and send to Oconto County, seconded by Pribyl with conditions. Motion carried, voice vote.
4. Little Suamico Youth Sports Booster Club Picnic Temporary Class "B/" Class B" Retailer's License Application-Action May be Taken- Allen motioned to approve the Temporary Class B, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.
5. Discuss purchase of replacement truck with Pierce- Dan Schultz from Pierce explained the new Fire Truck and the options to purchase. He also explained the price hike that will be coming up in November and the years to follow.

6. Little Suamico Fire Department Report- Chief Zuge went over his monthly report and stated there were 2 calls last month. Zuge also talked about the new Fire Truck proposal.
7. Community Policing Report- Deputy Baeten went over his monthly report and noted that there were 158 calls for the month of July. Baeten mentioned NNO was a huge success. Baeten will be holding a training at House of Worship on September 22, 2022.
8. Road Report- Town constituents spoke about speed limits in their area and on the roadways. The Town Board spoke about having someone from Highway Department or possibly the DOT to explain why the Town is unable to change the speed limits on the roads.
9. Planning Commission- Ragen stated he had a call regarding putting in more Condos by Geano's Beach and possibly a few businesses coming to the next meeting. He is keeping in contact with Economic.
