CALL MEETING TO ORDER-The opening meeting statement was read, and the Town Board of Supervisors monthly meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Chairman Ragen at the Town Hall. The meeting agenda notice was properly posted.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING(S)- Pribyl motioned to approve previous minutes, seconded by Allen.

1. Owner/Petitioner Beth Bardouche and Kathleen Crandell-Request a Land Division for parcel 024-071302441A3, to create 2 lots to be used as family residences consistent with the RR zoning, located in part of the NE ¼ of the SE ¼ of Sec 13, T26N, R20E-Action May Be Taken- Tracy Ondik explained the Rezone. After deliberations Pribyl stated this was straight forwarded and motioned to send onto Oconto County, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.
2. Discuss snowplowing 2022-2023 proposals- Action May Be Taken- Discussion was had within the Board and the Town Board went with Mike Mahr to plow the Town Hall, LSF, Recycling Center along with a small section of Cottage Road. Motion was made by Allen, seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.

4. Community Policing Report- Report was printed and posted on website.
5. Road Report- Chairman Ragen stated the road work would be coming to an end due to winter. He also discussed the Little Suamico Bridge repair that will be going on through part of next year.
6. Planning Commission- Chairman Ragen discussed continuing to try to get more businesses into the Town.

7. Approval of Bills- Action May Be Taken- Board went through all bills. Pribyl motioned to approve the Town bills, seconded by Allen. Motion carried, voice vote.

9. Resolution R2022-5 Town Electors Adopt the Town Tax Levy- 9 electors and 3 Town Board officials were present. Todd Zuge motioned to approve the 2023 Tax Levy, seconded by Ken Kleczka. There were zero electors who opposed the levy.
10. Adopt 2023 Town of Little Suamico Budget- The budget was reviewed by page followed with questions. Motion was made by Allen to approve the 2023 budget seconded by Pribyl. Motion carried, voice vote.
