Chairman's Monthly Report Highlights

February – 2026

Per monthly report requested by Electors at the 2025 Annual Mtg.

I hope next year (April 2027) a number of folks run for the Town Chair position, bringing in newer ideas, vision, and energy while working to keep our GREAT town moving in the right direction. So, review these monthly reports (on our town website) and feel free to contact me with any questions you may have about running or the official duties.
2. Discussed with Sanitary President development proposal within the sanitary district.
3. Prepared maps for Land Use discussion regarding Plan Commission for two proposals.
4. Meetings with Highway shop to monitor snow removal and salting efforts.
5. Meetings with staff on recycling and brush plans for this Spring.
6. Meeting with Oconto Falls City about information on those municipalities looking to merge with libraries and what their efforts mean for our town.
7. Meetings with Cedar Corp Engineer/Planning on maps for our Paser Report and Bridge Aid for 2026, also worked to define portions of proposed agreement regarding Lade Beach Road segment needing to be adopted by Town Board in February.
8. Prepared Agenda for this month's Plan Commission meeting. Chaired and Secretary of the mtg.
9. Ordered street signs.
10. Prepared Agenda for this month's Town Board mtg. Chaired meeting.
11. Reviewed monthly town bills and authorized their payments.
12. Reviewed staff timesheets and signed payroll for town staff.
13. I interviewed applicants for the Plan Commission positions available. Prepared nominations to be ratified by Town Board. Presented them.
14. Worked with staff on expansion option of the recycling center involving adjacent property owner.
15. Attended a day training on the Board of Review process.
16. Initiated review of town draft ordinances proposed by Ordinance Committee.

- 17. Conduct road inspections after snow falls. Any issues were addressed by Highway Snow removal. 94 miles of roads exist within the town.**
- 18. Worked with staff to open the Town Hall as a warming station, and stayed at Town Hall until power companies reported that all service was up and running within the town.**
- 19. Meeting with Pulaski School Bus company to address problem areas within the town for bus access.**
- 20. Worked with staff to pick up newly purchased John Deer Tractor with attachments.**
- 21. Completed paperwork on proposed Conditional Use sent to county planning staff.**
- 22. Received complaints on issues of snow plowing, our agenda formats, how taxes are received, and on neighbors.**
