

## Chairman's Monthly Report Highlights

**March – 2026**

*Per monthly report requested by Electors at the 2025 Annual Mtg.*

1. Meeting with Town Engineers to begin the work of planning Lade Beach Road improvement. Step 1 will begin mid March which is a mtg between the Town, County Highway and Engineers to map out each other's roles and responsibilities. Step 2 will begin the Road Assessment this spring.
2. Meeting with Sanitary President and Town Engineers to begin formatting a developer's agreement to be used with subdivisions as they come up.
3. Road inspection for potholes; ditch and drainage issues; trash and obstructions within right of ways began.
4. Contacts with Highway shop to monitor snow removal and salting efforts. My road inspections during ice and snow storms show we have had a great amount of cost to our snow budget while also taking a toll on our asphalt. Meaning a lot of potholes and shoulder damage. I check town roads in the morning, during these events, to identify and get ahead of problems with snow and ice and to coordinate with plows as needed through highway shop.
5. Continued meeting with staff on recycling and brush plans for this Spring.
6. Continued to meet with Oconto Falls to hear what other communities are doing to cut their library expenditures to Oconto county and Brown county, In order that we are not the last community standing holding the bill.
7. Prepared Agenda for this month's Town Board mtg. Chaired meeting.
8. Reviewed monthly town bills and authorized their payments.
9. Reviewed staff timesheets and signed payroll for town staff.
10. Followed up on complaints on a Conditional Use Permit.
11. Read and commented on the town draft ordinances proposed by Ordinance Committee.
12. Continued to Review and update Road Improvement strategy.
13. Held in-person hours at the Town Hall (approx. 15 hrs.).
