CALL MEETING TO ORDER-The opening meeting statement was read, and the Town Board of Supervisors monthly meeting was called to order at 6:01pm by Chairperson Mohr at the Town Hall. The meeting agenda notice was properly posted.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA- Motion made by Paape to approve the agenda as posted, seconded by Helmle. Approved by unanimous vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING(S):

1/12/2026 Minutes – Helmle motioned to approve the minutes, seconded by Paape. Approved with Pribyl and Krumrei abstaining.

2/09/2026 Minutes- Paape motioned to approve the minutes, seconded Krumrei. Approved with Pribyl and Helmle abstaining.

CORRESPONDENCE- Mohr read a letter from John Link, Chairman of the Ordinance Committee.

BUSINESS:

1. Little Suamico Fire Department Report - Member of the Fire Department- Chief Zuge went over his report of 4 calls in February. He stated the Town should be getting the updated contract with Abrams after their meeting this month after their monthly meeting. Chief Zuge answered questions from the Town Board.
2. Community Policing Report- Deputy Hanson went over his report and answered a few questions from the Town Board.
3. Park Commission Report- Krumrei went over the upcoming projects at the park.
4. Building Permit Fee Schedule/Road Construction Permit Update- Glinski went over the packets that were given to the Town Board due to him not being able to attend the meeting. After discussion Paape motioned to approve the new permit fee schedule, seconded by Pribyl. Approved by unanimous vote. Paape motioned that the Town continue to keep the \$100.00 administrative fee and leave to the discretion of the building inspector if he would like to keep his \$100.00 administrative fee, seconded by Helmle. Approved by unanimous vote.
5. Re appoint/appoint Plan Commission memberships- Mohr went over his and Liz Paape's appointments to the Plan Commission. Krumrei motioned to approve the appointments, seconded by Helmle. Approved with Paape and Mohr abstaining.
6. Approve new drafted Rental Agreements for Park and Hall- Glinski went over the small changes made to the rental agreements due to renters being slightly confused by the wording. She also added the fees to both the park and hall rental forms, so it's not needed to go to the fee schedule also. Discussion was had by the Town board. Paape motioned to approve the changes with adding that there will be a lose of the security deposit and a \$250.00 additional fee if keys are not returned after rental, seconded by Helmle. Approved by unanimous vote.
7. Discussion on Recycling Center- Pribyl and Krumrei went over the options for the compost with the rest of the Town Board and that they will be continuing to work on a plan, but they Recycling Center will not be taking any compost in April and they hope to have a conclusion as to what the Town will do with compost by May 1.
8. Approval of Bills- Paape motioned to approve the bills, seconded by Pribyl. Approved by unanimous vote.
9. Announcements/General Information/Supervisor Comment- None

12. Supervisor Report- All supervisors stated their reports will be posted on the website.
