CALL MEETING TO ORDER- Chris called the meeting to order at 4:31pm. The meeting agenda notice was properly posted.

**BUSINESS:**

1. Kitchen Redesign- Tracey stated it was slow moving but will have more information next month.
2. Pickleball Court Covering- Discussion was had on the covering of the pickleball court and Lisa will reach out to Don to see if there is any timeline or date as to when the company will be doing the work.
3. Batting Cage- Chris started the discussion on the batting cage project that the Friends of the Park will be having a golf outing for. Chris had sent the Commission a photo as to where it would possibly be placed and a discussion was held on whether a mower would need to get through and if it's good to have it right next to the baseball diamond. Chris then stated the cost would be around \$7000.00 and any remaining funds would be going to the playground from the golf outing. Lisa asked if any maintenance would be required and Lee stated there isn't any maintenance. Tracey motioned to approve the golf outing on June 5<sup>th</sup> with funds going to a batting cage with any excess funds going to the playground, seconded by Lee. Approved. Lisa spoke about the lack of communication between Friends of the Park and the Park Commission. It was then stated by most of the Commission that communication needs to be better. Todd also asked for this item to be placed on the agenda for May or June when we start to hold our meetings at the park to discuss placement.
4. Diamond 3- The commission discussed options.
5. Walkway- Lisa stated this was on the calendar for this Spring. The Commission asked if Tom from All Out could attend our next meeting. Lisa will reach out to Tom.
6. Ice Skating Rink- Tracey went over the ground being very uneven under the ice-skating rink and that this should be taken care of this spring/summer by removing a 50x100 section of sod to make the ground even.
7. Announcements- Todd and Tracey discussed that the water probably won't be turned on by the Easter Egg Hunt being held on April 4<sup>th</sup>. Lisa mentioned she would be applying for a grant to get more cameras at the park. Todd talked about getting the AED from a grant and LSFD paying the remaining balance to for the AED to place at the park. Lisa and Todd will work together by using the cameras to see where the best location to place it will be.
