3/9/2026 Minutes – Paape motioned to approve the minutes, seconded by Krumrei. Approved by unanimous vote.

3/12/2026 Minutes- Paape motioned to approve the minutes seconded by Helmle. Approved by unanimous vote.

BUSINESS:

1. Little Suamico Fire Department Report- Member of the Fire Department- Chief Zuge went over that there were 10 calls in the month of March. He mentioned that there was a blood drive on 4/14/26 at the Fire Station from 1pm-4pm. He thanked Supervisor Paape for all her hard work on the Town Board. He ended by letting residents know that the Fire Department will be opening at 6:30pm for anyone to view the new trucks prior to the Annual meeting on April 21st at 7pm.
2. Community Policing Report- Report was on the table and is posted on website.
3. Park Commission Report- Krumrei went over the upcoming things going on at the park.
4. Oconto Falls Town Administrator speaking about libraries and his County Proposal- Peter Wills was in attendance and went over the Tax Apportionment document regarding tax dollars to Brown and Oconto County libraries. Mr. Wills then went over that he wants to see the 11 towns in the County without libraries to join a joint library to not pay Brown County. He is looking for the Town of Little Suamico to meet and go over negotiations regarding a contracted library service from Oconto Falls Library. He would like to have something signed by June as the deadline is September 1st for DPI to conjoin libraries. Paape motioned to move further into negotiations with Oconto Falls joint library for the purpose of serving our students, community and reducing our budget, seconded by Helmle. Approved by unanimous vote.
5. Approval to submit Oconto County Recreation Project Application- Helmle stated to send in the grant application it needed Town Board approval. Paape motioned to approve the submission, seconded by Pribyl. Approved by unanimous vote.
6. 2026 Joint Marketing from TEDCOR- The Town Board discussed the \$500.00 invoice to TEDCOR and Pribyl motioned to not pay the invoice of extra tax dollars, seconded by Paape. Approved by unanimous vote.
7. Draft document review for request for bids (RFB) Roadside Ditch Cutting Services- Mohr went over the draft he created for Roadside Ditch Cutting and the entire Town Board liked the document, and they would like to use it as a template for all upcoming bids.
8. Lade Beach Road Project- Contract addition to add work of core samples to survey the roadbed- Mohr went over that a road assessment was needed on Lade Beach and the Town Board had the document from Cedar

Corporation. Krumrei motioned to approve the \$1500.00 for boring samples of the Lade Beach, seconded by Pribyl. Approved by unanimous vote.

9. Recycling Center/Compost- Krumrei went over all the items and fees he and Pribyl determined would be needed for the Town to take in brush and compost. After the Town Board deliberated Paape motioned to approve \$8000.00 to supply services to the community contingent on comments at the Annual Meeting, seconded by Pribyl. Approved by unanimous vote.
10. Approval of Bills- Paape motioned to approve the bills, seconded by Helmle. Approved by unanimous vote.
11. Announcements/General Information/Supervisor Comment- Mohr mentioned the storm coming.
